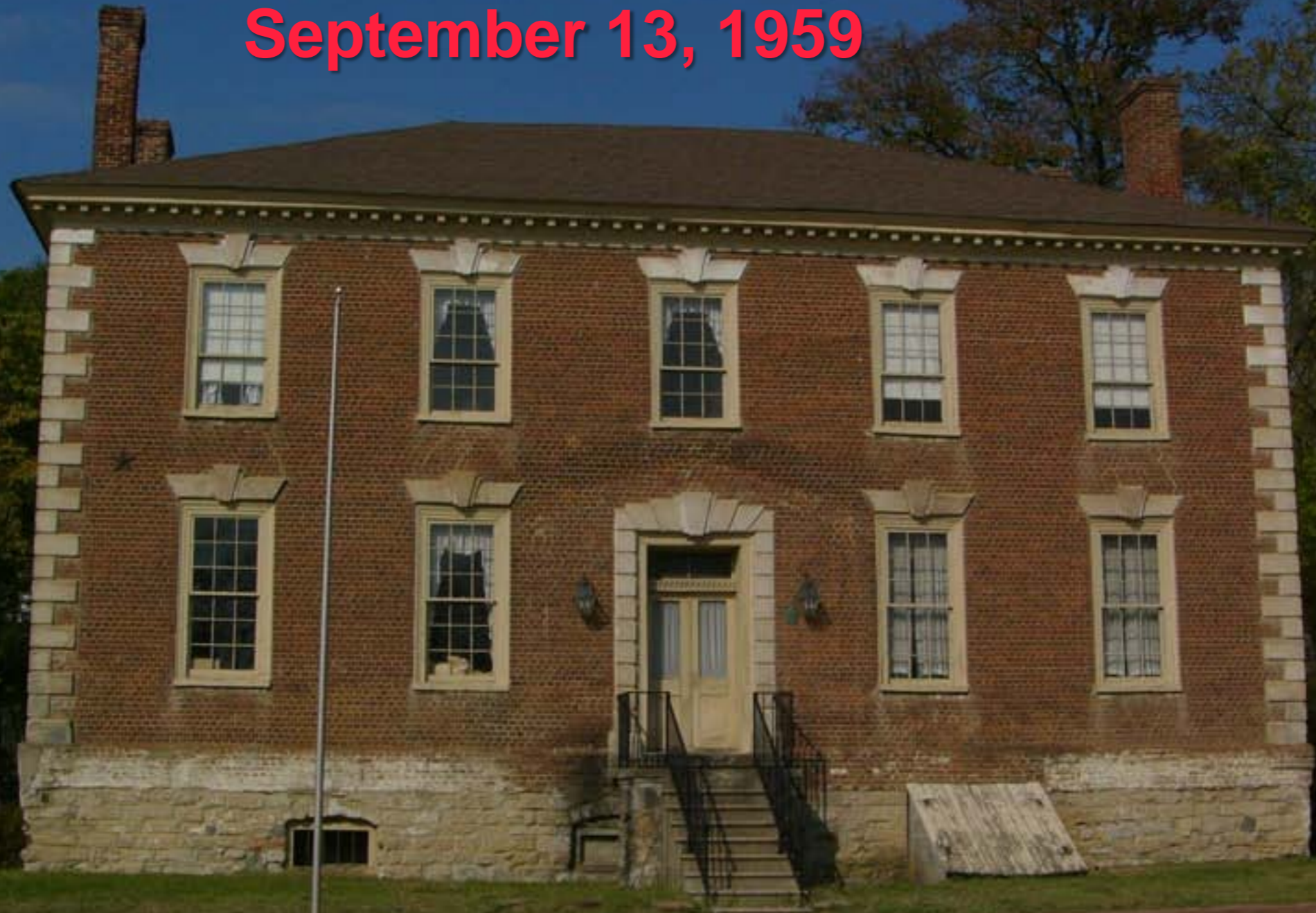

Major General Gerhardt W. Hyatt, Chief of Chaplains, 1971-1976

- Rev. Gerhardt Hyatt lived a prominent life. He was a general in the United States Army; chief of chaplains; president of Concordia College, Saint Paul, Minnesota; and vice president of The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod.
- **During his time in Washington, D.C., he helped to establish two parishes in the area: St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Falls Church, Virginia (1952), and Grace Lutheran Church in Woodbridge, Virginia (1959).**
- **George V McRee was Mission Pastor after Gen. Hyatt from 1962 - 1965.**

Ron was Grace's first called Pastor - Nov. 65 to Feb. 73. After 40 years of full time parish ministry, Pastor Ron Jackson "retired" in 1999.
